Ducks in a Row: Reedmaking Camp Required Materials

Here is a list of tools that you will need for reedmaking camp. You are welcome to bring, or purchase any of the optional supplies, but I have many extras that I will share with the group during camp. I have also included links to specific tools that I recommend. Always check in with your private lesson teacher before purchasing reed tools to get their recommendation!

Oboe in good working condition

Depending on how successful learning how to tie and scrape on reeds goes, it is possible that your student may go through quite a bit of cane. I recommend having too much cane than not enough. I would highly recommend 10-15 pieces for camp. I recommend 10.0/10.5 diameter and the Caleb -1 shape. http://hodgeproductsinc.com/cane/oboe-cane/shaped-oboe-cane/

Staples
